About Your SNT Team

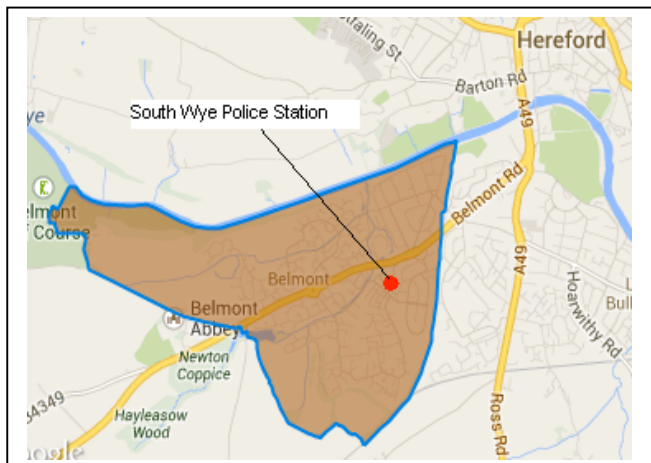
Safer Neighbourhood Teams work with local people and partners to identify, tackle and solve issues that matter to the community where you live.

Arrests of Note

39yr old male from Newton Farm (NF) arrested for breach of bail and detained for court
49yr old Hunderton female arrested wanted on warrant, and detained for court
25yr old male from Belmont arrested for drug driving and released on police bail
39yr old NF male arrested three times this month (2 x theft, 1 x breach of bail), charged and detained for court.

61 Crimes recorded for the month of September 2016, **10** have currently been detected, but others will be detected in coming weeks

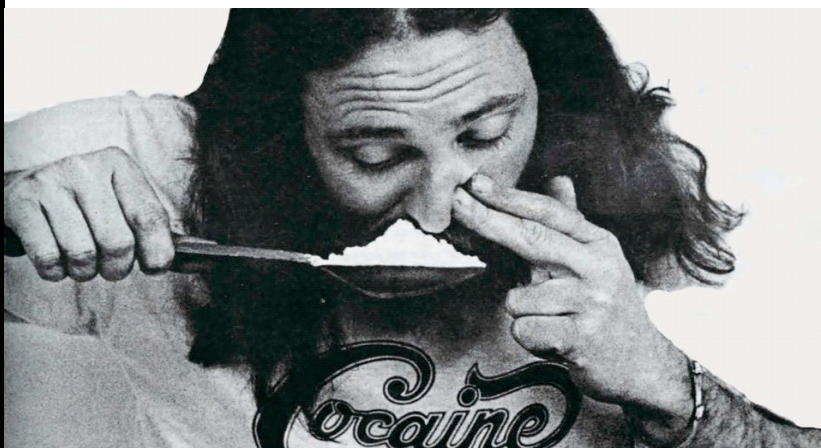

During the month of September 2016 we had **136** incidents reported to the police for the Belmont Safer Neighbourhood area, which were either attended or dealt with by us or response officers.

23 of these incidents were what we call "Grade 1", which means a 999 emergency call, which is either something life threatening or a crime in progress.
